## Day 1 - Welcome to Singapore!



Arrive at Changi International Airport where an English-speaking driver with a private vehicle will meet you for your transfer to the hotel.

After spending the day resting from your travels, you'll board an iconic Singaporean bumboat for a 30-minute tour on the Singapore River. During the ride from Clarke Quay to Merlion Park, you'll learn about the city's story from small trading port to world powerhouse.

Afterwards, dine at Din Tai Fung, an internationally beloved dim sum restaurant known for their xiao long bao (soup dumplings).

## Day 2 - The History of Singapore: Past to Present



Today, dive deeper into the history of Singapore from past to present. First, you'll visit Kampong Lorong Buangkok, one of the last remaining kampongs (meaning "villages" in Malay) in the city. Here you'll meet and mingle with residents and learn about how Singapore developed from villages to high rises.

For lunch, visit Lau Pa Sat (meaning "old market" in Hokkien), housed in a restored cast iron heritage site dating back 150 years. You'll get to choose from the best of local and international cuisines.

Afterwards, continue to Marina Bay, representing all things modern and stylish, and explore Gardens by the Bay. This premier attraction, opened since June 2012, includes two conservatories, the Cloud Forest and Flower Dome, as well as 18 Supertrees that house over 200 species of plants. As you wander through the conservatories and walk along OCBC Skyway, marvel at how far Singapore developed from kampongs to a leading global city of the 21st century. Dinner this evening is at your leisure.

## Day 3 - Singapore's Multiculturalism



Today you'll learn more about three major ethnic groups that make up Singapore – Malay, Chinese, and India – and how they have successfully blended to form a multicultural nation.

First, a visit to the National Museum of Singapore gives you an overview of how and when each ethnic group cemented their place in Singapore's history. We highly recommend exploring the Singapore History Gallery which charts the development of the island as it was known through the years as Singapura, a Crown Colony, Syonan-To, and finally, Singapore.

Afterwards, discover each of the ethnic groups' neighborhoods the best way possible: through food! Join a local guide on a bike tour (so you don't have to worry about the calories) through Chinatown, Kampung Glam, and Little India. As you sample each neighborhood's delicious food, you'll learn how the groups live harmoniously in Singapore today.

## Day 4 - Rest and Relaxation in the Garden City
